Girls

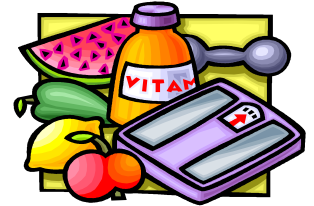
- Red school sweatshirt or cardigan

Year 6 are coming towards the end of their primary school education

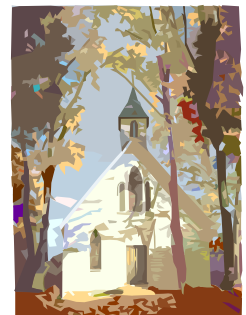
Our year 6 children will take their end of primary school tests (SATs) during the week beginning 11th May and we are confident that they will enjoy the success they deserve.
