## Homework

Homework will be given out weekly, on a Friday, to be handed in by the following Wednesday .

## Spellings

Spellings will continue to be given out each Tuesday. A spelling test will take place the following Monday. Your continued support in practising these spellings is gratefully appreciated.

## Reading

Reading books will be changed every Tuesday and Friday. You should encourage your child to read at home every day if possible, but certainly at least five times a week. Please ensure that your child's reading log is signed. We would like each child to put their reading book in the blue tray once the book has been read. This tray is clearly labelled and is kept in the cloakroom.

## PE

PE lessons will be on a Tuesday. Please make sure your child has full PE kit in school on this day. Please remember earrings should not be worn on PE days.

## History/Geography

As historians we will be focusing on Bridlington now and then , looking at the different changes to the seaside over the years.

As geographers we will be focusing on comparing the differences and similarities of the Hull and Bridlington landscape. We will be using geographical vocabulary to describe what we have learnt.

## Literacy

Our main areas of study will be:

- \* Story writing
- \* Diary writing

\*Writing questions

\*Non chronological reports

During literacy your child will be focusing on grammar, punctuation and guided reading.

## Numeracy

Our main areas of study will be:

- \*Ordering numbers
- \*Addition and Subtraction
- \*Multiplication and Division
- \*Fractions of numbers and shapes
- \*Problem solving

## Science

In Science our main topic will be ' Plants'. The children will identify and describe different types of plants and trees. They will be investigating how plants grow, by growing their own plants, and also focusing on what plants need to grow successfully.

## RE

In RE we will be answering the question "Who made the world?' The children will be looking at the creation story, and discussing how the world was made.

## Music

The children will continue to learn about how to make different sounds with their voices and follow short rhythmic patterns.

## ICT

During ICT we will be using the internet to research information about the Rainforest.

The children will continue using a range of different software e.g. word processing and art packages .

We will also continue to develop understanding of online-safety.

## Art/ DT

During our Art and DT lessons we will be making our own Seaside windmills. We will also be creating pictures of the Seaside using pastels.
