Spellings

Literacy

Our main areas of study will be:

- Authors and letters
- Narrative stories with added humour
- Biographies

We will also be looking at the story book, *Cliff-hanger* by Jacqueline Wilson.

Numeracy

Our main areas of study will be:

- Problem solving for all four operations
- Written multiplication and division methods
- Handling money

To access the new maths curriculum it is essential that children in year 3 know the times tables. I would appreciate if you could help their learning by practising the x3, x4 and x8 times tables at home.

Science

In Science we will be learning all about 'Light'. This will include investigating how shadows are formed and deciding on the most effective materials to protect our eyes from sunlight. Children's learning in Science will be supported wherever possible by practical activities and investigations.

RE / PSHCE

In R.E. we will look at and compare. Mrs Hudson shall be leading our PSHCE lessons every Monday.

History / Geography

Throughout our History and Geography lessons we will be focusing on the Ancient Greeks and the countries participating in the Olympic Games. We will use atlases and iPads to research and develop our understanding.

Art / DT

Our Art and DT lessons will relate to our theme of the Ancient Greeks. 3NT will be designing a new Olympic logo as well as building our own flickering Olympic torch by including electrical components.

ICT / MFL

In ICT we will mainly be focusing on sending and receiving emails. We will also continue further developing our word processing and presentation skills. Children will continue learning Mandarin Chinese taught by a teacher from Archbishop Sentamu Academy.

Music/P.E

In music, Class NT will be exploring the history of music and how to perform different styles. In P.E, we will be continuing to develop our techniques and skills in athletics and rounders.
